## Charles Hilton Architects

The homeowners tasked Charles Hilton Architects with creating a space for their large family to stay during the holidays. The team planned a guesthouse that matched the 1915 Stucco Colonial main estate, but also had a sense of ease. “The homeowners wanted the space to be light and airy,” Hilton says. The team created lots of room for entertaining, including a large combined living/dining room. Keeping the kids in mind, above the second floor bedrooms, the third floor boasts a children’s bunkroom where they can let loose. “We put soundproofing in the floor to really deaden the sound between the second and third floors,” Hilton says. As an added bonus, the team built a seating area behind the two-car garage, complete with a fireplace. “It’s really lovely in the evening when the lights are down low.” -NT
